

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ENACT ORDINANCE

CUMRU TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

Notice is hereby given that the Board of Commissioners of the Township of Cumru during a duly authorized meeting to be held on November 21, 2017 at 7:00 P.M. in the Commissioners Board Room of the Township Building located at 1775 Welsh Road, Mohnton, PA, shall consider enactment of an Ordinance, the full text of which is set forth below. A copy of the Ordinance is available for inspection at no charge or copies may be made at the Township rate at the Township Building located at 1775 Welsh Road, Mohnton, PA from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CUMRU, COUNTY OF BERKS, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 142, ADOPTED MAY 16, 1967, AS THEREAFTER CODIFIED BY ORDINANCE NO. 467, AS HERETOFORE AMENDED, KNOWN AS THE TOWNSHIP "TRAFFIC ORDINANCE," AS SET FORTH IN CHAPTER 15, "MOTOR VEHICLES" OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP OF CUMRU, ESTABLISHING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS ON CERTAIN STREETS, ESTABLISHING STOP INTERSECTIONS, ESTABLISHING PARKING REGULATIONS ON CERTAIN STREETS, AND DESIGNATING SNOW EMERGENCY ROUTES, DECLARING THE BALANCE OF THE SAID "TRAFFIC ORDINANCE" TO REMAIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT; AND, DECLARING THE PROVISIONS OF THE ORDINANCE TO BE SEVERABLE.

WHEREAS, the TOWNSHIP OF CUMRU has adopted Ordinance No. 142, thereafter codified by Ordinance No. 467, and has heretofore amended such Ordinance, such Ordinance, as amended to date being known as the Township "Traffic Ordinance," as set forth in Chapter 15 of the Code of Ordinances of the Township of Cumru, for the purposes, *inter alia*, of establishing Maximum Speed Limits on certain designated streets, of establishing Stop Intersections at certain locations in the Township; of designating snow emergency routes; and of establishing parking restrictions on certain streets; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the TOWNSHIP OF CUMRU desires to amend certain Sections of the "Traffic Ordinance;" and,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Commissioners of the TOWNSHIP OF CUMRU hereby Enacts and Ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. Part 2, "Traffic Regulations," Section 201, "Maximum Speed Limits Established on Certain Streets" of the aforesaid Chapter 15, hereby is amended by the addition of the following speed limitations:

<u>STREET</u>	<u>BETWEEN</u>	<u>MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT</u>
Goose Lane	Entire Length	35 MPH

SECTION 2. Part 4, “General Parking Restrictions,” Section 403, “Parking Prohibited at All Times in Certain Locations,” of the aforesaid Chapter 15, hereby is amended by the addition of the following parking restrictions:

<u>STREET</u>	<u>SIDE</u>	<u>BETWEEN</u>
Broad Street	Both	100 Block
Ardmore Avenue	Both	Twenty feet from intersection with Frederick Street
Frederick Street	Both	Twenty feet from intersection with Ardmore Avenue

SECTION 3. Section 5 of Article II of Ordinance 142, as the same has been codified, is hereby amended to read, in its entirety, as follows:

“Penalty for Violation of Parking Restrictions. Any person who shall violate any provision of this Article II (relating to Parking Restrictions) shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$20.00 and the costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment in the County Jail for not more than five (5) days.”

SECTION 4. The entire rest and remainder of Ordinance No. 142, known as the Cumru Township “Traffic Ordinance,” as amended and codified, shall continue in full force and effect, unaffected by the terms hereof, except as specifically amended herein.

SECTION 5. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance hereby are repealed, as is necessary, insofar as they are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6. The Township Solicitor is authorized and directed to do all such things, and to take such action, as is necessary, in order to effect the intent and purpose of this Ordinance.

SECTION 7. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid, for any reason whatsoever, such decision shall not

affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect; and, for this purpose, the provisions of this Ordinance hereby are declared to be severable.
